

# 2009 HYALITE CANYON AREA WINTER RECREATION

## Gallatin National Forest

**TRAIL DIFFICULTIES** are identified on the map with colored lines and symbols. During unusual snow conditions, ratings may be different.

**EASIEST:** Trails with relatively little challenge and can be negotiated by most skiers. Skiers can expect wider vegetation clearances and fairly flat grades with occasional short uphill and downhill pitches. Snow conditions can be variable.

**MODERATE:** Trails with moderate challenges that require intermediate skiing ability and techniques. Skiers need to expect steeper grades, reduced vegetation clearances, and more limited room to maneuver. Snow conditions can be variable.

**DIFFICULT:** Trails with difficult challenges that require advanced skiing ability and techniques. Skiers need to expect steep terrain, little room to maneuver, narrow vegetation, and inconsistent snow conditions.
